Mossman Gorge provides one of Australia's most iconic Indigenous experiences and is the perfect option for visitors looking for a genuine, authentic engagement with Indigenous Australia.

KEY INITIATIVES

ENERGY

The Mossman Gorge Centre boasts a 386 panel solar array and has utilised passive building design principles to reduce their energy consumption. Skylights allow natural light and cooling, windows are triple glazed and tinted green to reduce heat, LED lighting is used throughout the facility and is also set to interface with security systems so that the lights turn off when the building is locked.

WATER

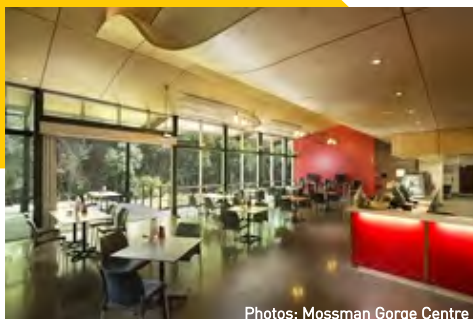
Designed to collect rainwater, the Mossman Gorge Centre has giant gutters on the ground level to catch rainwater, which is then stored in two underground water tanks. To reduce the Centre's water consumption, low-flow tap/shower adapters are in use throughout. Internal gardens have open skylights above them for access to rainwater and are mulched or covered in stone to conserve water.

MOSSMAN GORGE CENTRE

The Mossman Gorge Centre is an Indigenous ecotourism development, 20km north of Port Douglas. The Visitor Centre features an Art Gallery, Cafe & Restaurant, Gift Shop and provides accredited training courses to prepare Indigenous participants for work.

ECOBIZ CHAMPION

The Mossman Gorge Centre is dedicated to preserving the Daintree Rainforest where it is located. As a result of its sustainability efforts the Centre has been recognised as an ecoBiz Best Practice Partner, for energy and water and in 2018 attained Green Travel Leader Status from Ecotourism Australia.

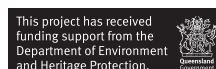
